# Sealant Application for Dental Assistants

## Course Information

- The dental assistant must provide certification of employment.
- The dental assistant must provide copy of *current* Coronal Polishing/Topical Fluoride Application certificate. If you did not submit this with your enrollment form mail a copy to the ODF offices at **317 NE 13<sup>th</sup> Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73104.**
- The dental assistant must provide a completed patient health history, patient consent form and a patient certificate with *six specific* teeth selected by the employing dentist and signed by the employing dentist. The assistant will not be admitted to the course without this information.
- The dental assistant is required to provide four extracted molar or premolar teeth that have been disinfected and mounted in stone. The mounted tooth should be easy to handle, root surfaces completely covered in stone and should be square in shape so that the tooth will sit upright on a lab bench. The mounted teeth should be free of restoration. Mount each tooth separately or two teeth together, leaving enough room between them to work. The clinical crown of the tooth should be free of any debris and should not be covered in stone.
- Equipment needed for the course:
  1. **4 hole** slow speed hand-piece motor & quick disconnect (i.e. Star or Midwest).
  2. slow speed nose cone or prophyl angle, and contra angle.
  3. latch angle green and white stones.
  4. disposable prophyl angles. (4)
  5. curing light and shield.
  6. patient chain for bib.
  7. millers forceps (**articulating ribbon**)
- Clinical/Lab Attire:
  1. assistant should wear scrubs and long sleeve coat or gown.
  2. tennis shoes
  3. protective eyewear.
- Examination Information:
  - A. Written Exam 40% (Multiple choice, true/false)
  - B. Lab Exam 20% (Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory)
  - C. Clinical Exam 40% (Evaluated on placement of 4 sealants)
- The dental assistant must achieve a score of 70% to pass the course.
- After completing the course, the dental assistant must place eight sealants in the private practice under the direct supervision of the employing dentist before they will be certified in sealant application.
- The dental assistant may have more than one patient if needed to fill the requirement of four sealants, or more than four teeth that have been selected by the employing dentist in one patient in case a selected tooth is rejected. **Patient selection is critical. We recommend you select a patient that is manageable. Your patient should not be under six (6) years of age.**
